



Qualification Criteria for Commonwealth Games – Glasgow 2026

Team sports and Para sports have set qualification criteria by the IF's, individual sports have open criteria and the NNOC will determine the qualification standards:

- The total quota for the individual sports 2026 – 21 athletes.
- The total quota for the team sports and para sports will be additional to the above quota.

ALL SPORT CODES:

- All continental championships shall have a minimum of four countries taking part. In the event of the continental championship has less than four countries partaking or is cancelled, the IF world ranking on 31st May 2022 will be taken into consideration and placement among the top 2 African Countries shall qualify. The ranking relative to the other Commonwealth countries in Africa will be considered
- The Qualification period is from June 1, 2025 until May 31, 2026
- Athletes who have had international exposure as well as Athletes who are Paris OS scholarship holders will have preference.
- The names for athletes and coaches with a copy of their passports valid until January 2027 for the long list must be submitted to the NNOC office not later than Friday 29th October.

AQUATICS:

The time equal to 8th place in the semi-finals of the Commonwealth Games 2022 to qualify for the finals will be the qualifying time.

- The performance must be achieved once between 1st June 2025 up to 31st May 2025 of the swimming season.
- Performances must be achieved during competitions sanctioned by World Aquatics.

For field events and marathon, the result (time / distance) of the 8th placing of the overall results of Commonwealth Games 2022.

- Performance must be achieved between 1st June 2025 up to 31st May 2026 Athletics season.
- Performances must be achieved during competitions sanctioned by World Athletics.
- Wind assisted performances will not be accepted.

GYMNASTICS (ARTISTIC AND RHYTHMIC)

Qualify through continental championships sanctioned by FIG

Must achieve top two in Africa.

PARA- SPORT

The NNOC is limiting the quota for Para sport to a maximum number of 4, including guides.

Para-athletes are selected according to IPC criteria.
